Office of the Commissioner of Insurance-Regulatory Issue Update

Commissioner of Insurance, Sean Dilweg and Jennifer Stegall, Policy Advisor at OCI attended the Wisconsin Land Title Association Convention in Ashland this past September. In his presentation to members, Commissioner Dilweg, promoted a continuing dialogue with our industry on issues important to us as well as to the OCI.

The Commissioner's Title Advisory Council was set up early in 2007 by the OCI as a way of educating and communicating with them on industry issues. The meetings of the Council are held quarterly and are open to the public. The next meeting is this Friday, November 14 at the OCI offices at 124 South Webster St., Room 227, Madison. The meeting times are from 10 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. (Attached you will find a notice of the meeting, an agenda and some attachments from the OCI for this meeting)

Some of the issues mentioned by Commissioner Dilweg in his September presentation to WLTA members included a continued dialogue on affiliated businesses, pricing, a new licensing exam, the possibility of pre and/or post licensing education and consumer education and protection. These are all subjects identified by WLTA members as important to them as per the survey sent out early in 2007.

WLTA has asked the OCI to answer the question, "Who should be licensed" and we look forward to an answer at the meeting this week.

We will be communicating with members immediately after this meeting to inform everyone on what discussions took place as we continue to keep you informed.
