#### **Application for Exam Procedure Includes Criminal Background Check**

The OCI requires a crime check on each exam candidate. At the time of making your reservation for the exam, candidates will be required to pay the exam fee PLUS an additional fee for the Identification Record Request & Fingerprinting. PEARSON VUE will then electronically submit the candidate information to the FBI. The results of the record request will be sent directly to the OCI for review and consideration.
